



**REPUBLIC AND TORODA CREEK GRABENS
AEROMAGNETIC SURVEY**
Okanogan and Ferry Counties, Washington

A detailed aeromagnetic survey of the Republic and Toroda Creek grabens was flown by Hunting Geophysical Services, Inc. in 1959. Five 15-minute quadrangles were surveyed. (See location map overleaf.) The data were published by the Washington Division of Mines and Geology in 1960. The publication is now out of print. *EDCON-PRJ* has digitized the maps and merged the data into a single grid.
